

LAKE NAKURU TOUR 2017



DAY 1 - LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

Your parents will drop you at school by 7.00am and at 7.30 you will assemble and after a prayer and a short briefing by our representative, you will board the vehicle and start on an adventure journey to the Great Rift Valley. You will have a brief stop to be explained on how the Great Rift Valley was formed at the viewpoint. Named in honour of a Scottish explorer John Walter Gregory, who was the first European to see and research about it, it divides Kenya neatly down the length of the country essentially separating east from west. You will thereafter, proceed further towards Hells Gate National Park, where you will have your lunch at a picnic site at the shores of L. Naivasha. Afterwards, proceed to Lake Nakuru National Park for dinner and overnight at *Sarova Lion Hill or similar*

DAY 2 - LAKE NAKURU

L. Nakuru is famous for its flamingos and not forgetting other wildlife like Black and White Rhino, Leopards, Rothschild's Giraffe and many more. After your breakfast you will embark on a game drive through the park that takes you to the Lake shores to watch the amazing birds, flamingos. You will also proceed to the baboon cliff just to have a look at the whole park from an aerial view. Afterwards have a game viewing drive through the park as you return to the hotel for Lunch.



Afternoon will be spent at leisure at the hotels swimming pool with an option of an evening game drive in search for the animals not seen so far. Dinner and overnight at the *Sarova Lion Hill or similar*

DAY 3 - NAIROBI

Immediately after breakfast you will board your vehicles ready for an early game drive through the park. This is the best time for game viewing as the animals are actively feeding. Afterwards you will proceed to the lodge for check out and early lunch, before proceeding on past the Great Rift Valley view Point to Nairobi carrying with you the memories of the Great Rift Valley. You will be dropped at your school to be picked by your parents.

The package include.

- Accommodation and meals on full board
- Transport throughout the safari
- Game drives in the park
- Services of a professional driver guide/guide
- Park entrance fees
- A soft drink after every meal

The cost excludes:

- Personal items like telephone, laundry etc.
- Anything else not included above

- *Kids to carry packed lunches on the first day*
- *We will take one teacher free for every ten students*
- *Accommodation is 3 pupils in a room*
