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STUDENTS MOMBASA ROAD TOUR 2017



Day 1: Nairobi to Mombasa Island

Your parents will drop you at your school at around 6.00 am where you will assemble for briefing from Fountain Safaris representative before boarding the bus for the trip to Mombasa.

Mombasa offers a diverse cultural history. The City traces most of its cultural traditions to former Portuguese, Arab and British settlers all who left a lasting influence on the City's food, architecture, and people. The city has undoubtedly one of the best white sandy beaches in Africa, the warm waters of the Indian Ocean cater to all types of tourists.

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Day 2: Malindi

After a sumptuous breakfast you will drive north towards Malindi, past the Arabuko Sokoke forest, the biggest indigenous forest in E. Africa. You will proceed to **Gedi ruins** a historical site the 3rd most visited museum after Nairobi and Fort Jesus. This is a deserted site, which not much is known about and the little that is known is linked to the items that were found there. You will also visit the museum, which has the Swahili artifacts, and many other items that were recovered from the site. You will afterwards proceed to the **Malindi Marine Park**. Depending on the level of the water you can take a boat ride or even walk about 500 meters in the ocean. Here you will have an explanation of the kind of fish that you can find around the area, the importance of coral reef and how they are formed. Return to the hotel for Dinner and overnight at *Sarova Whitesands Beach Resort and spa*.

DAY 3: Explore Mombasa Island

This day after your breakfast you will have a city tour of Mombasa and visit the major highlights like the **Fort Jesus**, the narrow streets, the hanging balconies, the Akamba wood carvers and much more. Proceed to yet another adventure as you visit the former Bamburi nature trail currently called **Haller Park**. This is the only place in Kenya where you can see the giant tortoises in large numbers and go close to even touching them. You will be guided through the trails to the fishponds and through the crocodile farm. Here also, learning takes place as you will be taken through a lecture of how the fish and the crocodiles are bred, how and why albino crocodiles, and fish come up. Also you will learn how the plants and trees have adopted the salty soils and the symbiotic relationship between the millipedes and the casuarina trees. There are a number of animals and birds to be seen here like Hippos, Buffalo, Elands, Crowned crane, Sacred Ibis and many more.

After lunch we will drop you at Mombasa drop off at *Mombasa Go-Kart* (open from 4pm) and Wild waters. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight at *Sarova Whitesands Beach Resort and spa*.

Day 4: Depart Mombasa

After your breakfast you will leave Mombasa for the trip back to Nairobi.
